<p><b><u>Timeline of Events</u></b></p> <p>Watch the film that we're focusing on in lessons and make a timeline of the plot. Copies of the films are available to order on Amazon but please do let school know if this is a problem.</p>	<p><b><u>Fact File</u></b></p> <p>Use IMDB.com a fact file of the films we have been studying. You should include: <i>director, producer, production company, budget, cast, key locations, release date, money made at the box office &amp; fun facts</i></p>	<p><b><u>Character Profile</u></b></p> <p>Choose one character from the film we are currently studying and create a character profile for them. Include: <i>Their name, age, location, a photo, what happens to them in the film, their friends and relatives in the film, key quotes and interests</i></p>
<p><b><u>Trailer / Scene Analysis</u></b></p> <p>Watch the trailer or a key scene from the film we're studying. Write an analysis of how the director uses film language to present the key issues and themes.
