Course Summary

The A level Spanish qualification provides the opportunity to further develop the linguistic skills acquired in Spanish GCSE through the studies of wide-ranging contemporary social issues and trends. The two-year course enables students to explore aspects of social, political and artistic life within Spain and Hispanic countries. It is a course which will foster a range of transferable skills, such as communication, critical thinking, research skills and creativity all of which will be vital for employment or further study. In addition, the students will have the opportunity to explore Spanish culture through the study of literature and film.

How will I be assessed?

AS Spanish

- Listening, Reading and Writing (1 hours 45 minutes) 45%
- Writing (1 hours 30 minutes) 25%
- Speaking (12-14 minutes) 30%

A Level Spanish

- Listening, Reading and Writing (2 hours 30 minutes) 50%
- Writing (2 hours) 20%
- Speaking (21-23 minutes) 30%
